

Environmental law is now a fundamental right included in the Constitution (Environmental Charter). The notion of environment and the emergence of environmental law.

Sources of environmental law: written sources of international law, the European Union and national unwritten sources. The main principles of environmental law: fundamental principles and the principles of environmental action (prevention, information and citizen participation, polluter pays, precautionary).

Environmental policies: the policy at national, European and international, the broad legislative (law of nature, law of pollution and nuisances, right risks).

The administration of the environment: birth and evolution, central administration, decentralized administration.
