

The course is an introduction to the British public law (constitutional and administrative law). After introducing the concept of constitution and its sources, fundamental principles of British constitutionalism (supremacy of parliament, separation of powers and rule of law) will be studied in the light of the influence of european law. Then the composition and functions of the parliament and the government will be presented as well as the devolution process. The judicial review (control of administration acts) will be discussed in the last part.
